The Truth About Dreams:

Everyone dreams. Everyone dreams every night. 1/3 of your life is spent in the dream world. While your body rests your subconscious mind is actively involved in dreaming.

Consider this, “we are living in the last days, during the last times.” God is pouring out His Spirit in unlimited proportions, and as a result, along with other manifestations, we will notice that people will experience more and more encounters with God through dreams that they will remember.

An important thing to realize about dreams is that they do not only explain current situations, our future will help to explain the dream because every dream unfolds, just as prophecy does. A dream that you had 10 years ago could be relevant today with an application that aligns with your current existence.

Do Not Interpretations Belong to God?

This was the response of Joseph after Pharaoh's chief butler and chief baker dreamed a dream. Joseph was careful, as was Daniel, and so many others, to give God the credit for the interpretation of dream.

Interpretations are from God, this applies, of course, when the dream itself is from God.

Here's another thought, have you ever awoken knowing you had a dream, but, the dream you had is forgotten? Rest assured that instructions are sealed inside of you, the dreamer when that happens.

School of thought: Be prepared to record or journal your dream upon waking.

Job 33:14-16 "God speaks once, twice, yet man perceives it not. In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falls on men, as they slumber on their bed; He opens the ear and seals their instruction."

It's important to remember to acknowledge the Holy Spirit, who is our comforter, the Spirit of truth, who helps us bear the truth and reminds us of what Jesus has said, and He is also our guide. However, we must yield to his help. (Jn. 16:13-14)

In this guidebook, I gave you 8 keys that unlock the revelation, understanding, and application of your dream experience.

Keys/Color Code

Definitions of the 8 keys to identify

Key #1: Location is the setting where the action in the dream takes place.

Key #2: Condition is the requirement to be met.

Key#3: Who outlines the people represented in the dream.

Key #4: What is the verb in the dream that is happening.

Key #5: Why is the cause, reason, or purpose for why you did what you did in the dream.

Key #6: Something Happening/Something being Experienced is the effect that the action in the dream is having on the subject.

Key #7: Symbols are objects in the dream that have a meaning other than what they appear as. Numbers can be symbolic as well as logos and icons. Always remember that symbolism is drawn from the dreamer and therefore may change from one dreamer to the next.

Key #8: Application is instruction or direction within the dream that should be applied by the dreamer.

Finally, Dream Interpretations are submissions that are a Holy Spirit-led explanation of some of the possibilities regarding the dream. We take a look at the details of the dream to consider the following:

- Origin ✓
- Intrinsic ✓
- Extrinsic ✓
- Both Intrinsic and Extrinsic ✓
- Interpretation ✓
- Scriptural References ✓

There are additional keys, but we will begin with the eight listed above.

Tips:

When mapping another's dream, do your best to stay out of it. Also, do not limit your interpretation based on your knowledge of the dreamer. However, you are to take into consideration the dreamer's upbringing, culture, and nationality.

Everything needed to understand the dream is included in the 8 keys above. Do not add or leave any one of them out.

Lastly, after listing the details included in the dream using all 8 keys, present your Dream Interpretation and scriptural reference for your findings.

Let's map the dream using the 8 keys listed above.

 **Key 1**

Location

Location is the setting where the action in the dream takes place.

 **Key 2**
Condition

Condition is the Requirement to be met.

 **Key 3**
Who

Who outlines the people represented in the dream.

 **Key 4**

What

What is the verb in the dream that is happening.

 **Key 5**

Why

Why is the cause, reason, or purpose for why you did what you did in the dream.

Key 6

Something Happening/Something Being Experienced

Something Happening/Something being Experienced is the effect that the action in the dream is having on the subject.

Key 7

Symbols

Symbols are objects in the dream that have a meaning other than what they appear as. Numbers can be symbolic as well as logos and icons. Always remember that symbolism is drawn from the dreamer and therefore may change from one dreamer to the next.

Key 8

Application

Application is instruction or direction within the dream that should be applied by the dreamer.
